Purpose of Public Meeting:

The purpose of this open house is to inform the public of the data collection results associated with this study, and allow residents and stakeholders to provide input related to issues and opportunities that should be addressed.

Overview of the Study:

The Local Area Parking Study in Wellington West is in alignment with the [Municipal Parking Management Strategy](#) and is part of a broader initiative to develop a Kitchissippi Parking Strategy which is focussed around Wellington Street West / Richmond Road.

This study area is based around Wellington Street West between Island Park Drive and the O-Train tracks, but also extends to fully consider the residential areas to the north and south of Wellington.

In addition to the data collection that has taken place, local stakeholders have been consulted throughout the study process to ensure transparency and that the parking needs of the local community are accurately assessed. Any additional feedback related to parking issues or opportunities will be welcomed until April 29th, 2016.
