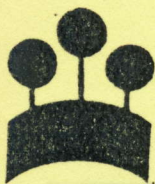

NEWS RE YOUR ASSOCIATION

1. DISEASE CONTROL CENTRE-TUNNEY'S PASTURE

Health and Welfare informs us that the testing of current emissions and the environmental assessment of the proposed new facility should be completed in about a month. We will inform you when the report is available.

2. PROPOSED INCORPORATION OF YOUR ASSOCIATION

To protect members of the association from any liability problems the executive is considering incorporating as a non-profit organization. This may require revision of our constitution. We will discuss the incorporation with you on April 10 after the park discussion. In the meantime if you wish to obtain a copy of the current constitution or express your opinion on the proposed incorporation, please feel free to call any member of your executive.

3. DRAFT OTTAWA OFFICIAL PLAN

City Council has agreed to a central area capacity analysis study as suggested by the business community but opposed by most community associations. As well a Forum on the Central Area will be held in June. If you have concerns or suggestions about the future development of downtown Ottawa I suggest you contact Jamie Fisher 564-1323 or your executive to express these. The plan will also be changed to contain an environmental mission statement as an overriding aim. The need for an urban conservation strategy will be recognized and is to be developed in the next year.
