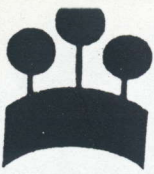

Association News

Bridge news! Members of your executive have been attending many meetings re the proposed bridges. The main public meeting of Mar. 23 on the bridges (four main options-Britannia-Deschenes, twinning Champlain, Lemieux Island and Kettle Island) did not finish and will be continued at 5:00 P.M. on Apr. 13 at R.M.O.C., 111 Lisgar St. As you may be aware the Executive Committee of Regional Council passed a motion to advise the NCC that no action should be taken on widening the Champlain Bridge. As well they have indicated they do not support the use of Kirkwood Ave. or Churchill Ave. as potential arterial connections to an interprovincial bridge, thus reducing the chance that the twinning of Champlain Bridge option will be chosen. Without other openings to the Western Parkway, a third lane would result in increased traffic on Island Park Drive and connecting streets. The Apr. 2 Citizen reported that the bridge-widening option won't be brought forward by the NCC again, unless there is greater willingness by Ottawa-Carleton to co-operate on the issue. Chair Peter Clark's letter to Chairman Marcel Beaudry of the NCC made several suggestions: two left turn lanes from the bridge to the Parkway east during the morning rush, or restricting access for an hour of the rush-hour to cars with at least two passengers; expansion of transit service frequency, using dedicated lanes; and implementation of a ride-sharing demonstration project. These seem like reasonable suggestions. You can add your voice to the debate by writing Mr. M. Beaudry, Chairman, National Capital Commission, 161 Laurier Ave. West, 14th floor, Ottawa, Ont. K1P 6J6, supporting these or your own suggestions.
