



#### 394 TREES MAPPED

Volunteer tree mappers received training in the spring of 2016. The area they mapped is about 1/5th of the neighbourhood.



# MOST FREQUENT SPECIES

32% are sugar maple, bur oak & silver maple

47% of shade canopy comes from these

We need to diversify.

3 species

#### 75% ARE NATIVE SPECIES

Norway Maple is the most common nonnative species. City of Ottawa no longer plants this tree but landscapers do. We need to stop this.

## ONLY 18% ARE >41 CM

An accepted target for DBH >41 cm in an urban environment is 30%. We must conserve big trees or fall further behind.

## PLANTING NEW TREES

18 plantable spots exist on city right-ofway. We encourage people to replenish trees destroyed due to infill housing.
