1. Champlain Park Community Association

- Volunteer organization which provides and co-ordinates many community activities

- 2. Federation of Civic Associations in Ottawa Fédération des associations civiques d'Ottawa (FCA-FAC)
- Umbrella group of over 70 community associations from within the Ottawa region
- "We connect local community groups to share resources and idea.
 Together we advocate at City Council to build stronger neighbourhoods"

- Ongoing committees on Transit, Planning and Zoning and recently External Relations
- Provides a collective voice for community associations to elected officials and agencies

3. Kitchissippi Ward Informal working group (K-9)

- Includes representatives from the nine community associations in the Kitchissippi Ward
- Exchanges information, identifies and discusses issues of interest to Kitchisippi Ward residents
- No website but information passed forward to community associations.

4. Neighbours for Tunneys Group

- Started in early 2021 in response to a lack of public consultation on the Tunney's Pasture Redevelopment project since 2014
- Includes representatives from the community associations which border on Tunney's Pasture

5. Community Perspectives Advisory Group

- Advisory group established this Fall by Public Services and Procurement Canada and Canada Lands Corporation the two federal agencies overseeing the development plan for Tunney's Pasture.
- Direct result of lobbying and advocacy by the Neighbours for Tunney's Group.
- Heather Pearl and Roland Dorsay have been selected as members of this body.

Last Points

- Champlain Park "hits above its weight" taking leadership roles in above mentioned groups
- Champlain Park Association members are involved in other groups such as Peoples Official Plan, Community Associations for Environmental Sustainability, Walkable Ottawa.
- One does not have to be a Board member to become involved in civic organisations
